Introduction Summary

The Brisbane studio of COX has a long and very proud history of commitment to social and affordable housing stretching back over 25 years to the very earliest days of the local practice, starting with the design and delivery of the Church Street Housing in Fortitude Valley in 1992/93 for the then Department of Housing. Since that time our Brisbane studio has delivered a multitude of different low scale, medium density, and affordable housing projects.

Our demonstrated commitment to affordable housing for over a quarter of a century and the long-term consistency of our professional staff, has allowed us to develop a significant body of knowledge and a continuity of developing thought which means COX are ahead of others in this sphere. We look forward to continuing our commitment to this very important typology and the opportunity of applying our hard-won knowledge to benefit future projects.

Sector Knowledge

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This now includes our most recent project 78 Brisbane Rd, Labrador, a 4-storey sub-tropical and cross-ventilated complex of 20 No. single bedroom dwellings. We take our social responsibilities as architects very seriously, in the knowledge that with our design skills and using a sensitive approach, we can make a positive contribution to the betterment of people's lives through an uplifting experience of their day-to-day living environment.

Our commitment to this typology includes a significant portion of pro-bono design work for organisations such as Youngcare and the Property Industry Foundation, where we have completed such projects as the Women's Shelter Creche for St Mary's Play/Grow, and soon to complete the Youth Homeless Accommodation Centre at Sandgate Rd.

COX understands that affordable and social housing is a fundamental element of the accommodation spectrum required by Queenslanders today and it is essential that these options are supplied in a variety of forms. We aim to design projects that deliver dignified living options that satisfy the needs of low-cost housing in ways that subtly integrate with the existing neighbourhoods. An important principle that has arisen in this space is the understanding of trauma-informed design. To assist our team in designing buildings in response to this principle, we recently developed a research paper that presents an informed framework for designing to this typology.
